PAGE ONE (seven panels)

<u>Panel 1:</u> A thin horizontal panel, which spans the page width. It contains only the title.

TITLE:

Open Door

<u>Note:</u> The remaining six panels are all the same size, and have the same camera angle. Each panel is the view seen by a stationary baby monitor camera. There are two panels per row.

<u>Panel 2:</u> Daytime. In a living room. A baby sits on the carpet and plays with toys. There is a large glass sliding door behind the baby, which leads to the yard. The door is open.

 $\underline{\textbf{Panel 3:}}$ A giant tarantula crawls down the outside of the glass door. The spider is about two metres long.

<u>Panel 4:</u> The spider stands in the open doorway. Part of its head is through the doorway.

Panel 5: The spider lunges forward and grabs the baby between its
front legs.

<u>Panel 6:</u> The spider climbs up the outside of the glass door. Only the lower half of its abdomen and back legs are visible. The baby is gone.

Panel 7: The spider is gone.
